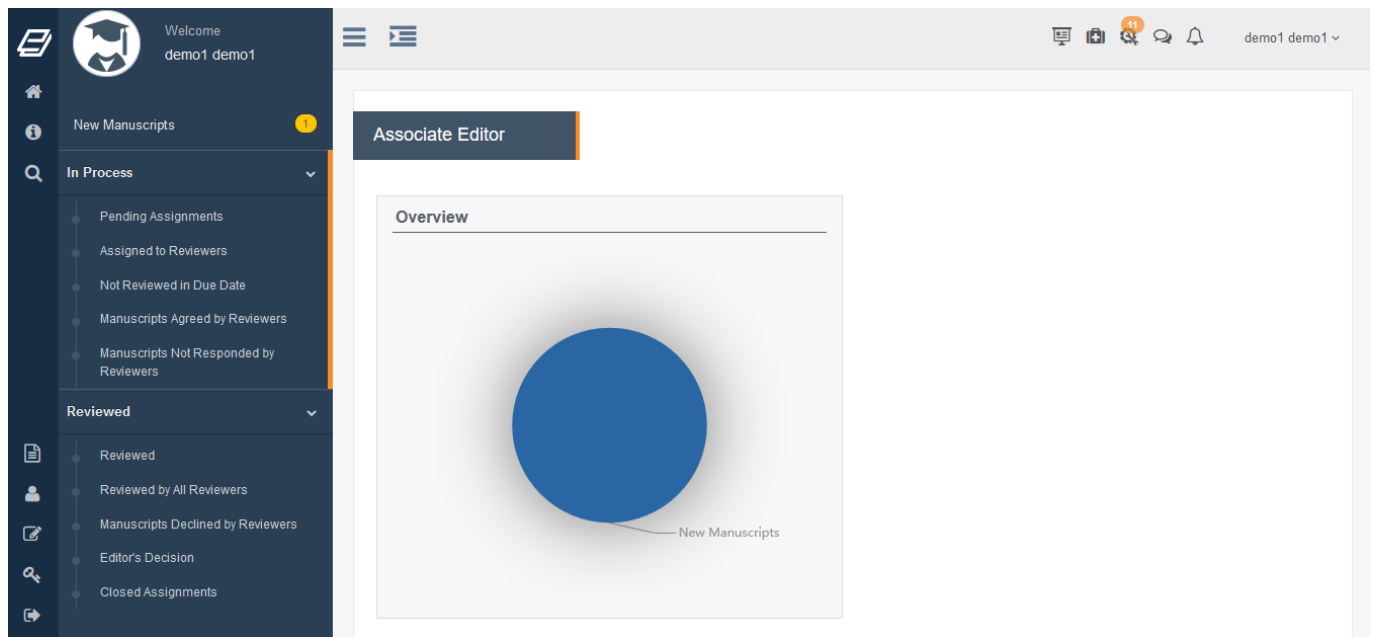


Associate Editor
